## **Internal Medicine case series**

A 49 yr old female got admitted with h/o illness since 3 months. Started with polyarthralgia. Small and large joints, erythematous maculopapular rash over face and neck. Was referred as a case of Stevens Johnson syndrome secondary to T. Diclofenac for 10 -15 days. She was admitted in respiratory ICU also had COVID RTPCR Negative pneumonia. She Had anemia, mild hepatic dysfunction. She had severe lower limb weakness and was bed ridden for 1 month. Considering a multisystem involvement, her ANA blot was sent. Her RA factor came positive (108.1IU/ml), ESR-86. CRP- 50.ANA positive. Rib- PO 3.3 positive, dsDNA negative. Detail history, examination and assessment is utmost important.
