Answer 6:

the CT scan shows thin flap at proximal descending aorta - hall mark finding in aortic dissection..

A hypertensive patient with severe back pain and chest pain with asymmetric arm BP is typical presentation; CT angiogram timing and thin resolution images Is necessary to make the acute diagnosis. In this scan, the ascending aorta is not involvement – stanfard B type.

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
